### The shift from ENP to EU Enlargement Policy as both realist/pragmatic and normative/value-based


#### False dichotomy?

- the support of the normative world order as a rules-based order is pragmatic
- key concept of the realist paradigm "national interest". For democracies national interests include (support of) democracy, rule of law, human rights, and democratic values as core principles
- + The difference in EU response for 2008 / 2014 and 2022

### The shift from ENP to EU Enlargement Policy as both realist/pragmatic and normative/value-based


- Ukraine's accession has a major potential to strengthen the security and defence policy and geopolitical weight of the EU itself.
- As the threat of Russia's military aggression is perceived as real there is a need for EU's stronger defence and military policies and joined programmes including their "hard power" aspects.
- Russia's defeat and restoration of Ukraine's territorial integrity as preconditions for restoring the broken rules-based order in Europe and beyond.
- EU membership would ensure sustainable security for Ukraine. If Ukraine advances on the EU accession path, its recovery will be more sustainable and its economy more attractive to EU investors. Economically developed and sustainable and thus secure Ukraine is vital for improving the shared security of Eastern Europe.




#### Dynamics of support for joining unions


#### Usefulness and sufficiency of EU support

How do you evaluate the usefulness of EU efforts How do you evaluate sufficiency of EU efforts to to support Ukraine?





### How would you rate the level of democracy in Ukraine in general (not taking into account the temporary restrictions due to martial law)?







#### Democracy has deep roots in our country






### Democratic values are less important than security for my country






### If the country is doing well economically, I don't care who is in power






### The EU demands our government to be more democratic








### Traditional values of my country are threatened by European values






